- e) Identify **FOUR** pillars of Islam faith (4 marks)
- f) Expound on the two dating systems that exist among the Western and the Muslim systems (4 marks)

QUESTION TWO (10 marks)

Islam's Conquests became Successful in North Africa. Evaluate:

- a) The reasons that the Christians found Islam appealing? (5 marks)
- b) God's commissioned to Mohammed, according to Quran (5 marks)

QUESTION THREE (10 marks)

Muslims are from the ancestry of Abraham.

- a) If you were the president today, what role would you give to a qualified Muslim in your government and why? (5marks)

- a) Use a diagram to illustrate Mohammed's ancestry from Ishmael. (5 marks)

QUESTION FOUR (10 marks)

“All Nations” includes the Muslims in Africa and elsewhere.

- a) Determine how a Christian can make changes that may remove certain cultural stumbling blocks to relate to a Muslim effectively. (5 Marks)
- b) Compare how a Muslim views sin versus the Christian perspective. (5 marks)
