Question 1

Question 2

- b) **Explain** how Apostle Paul embodies his missional identity through his actions, faithfulness, and influence. What lessons can we learn from his example? (5 Marks)

Question 4

- a) **Describe** how your natural abilities and spiritual gifts empower you to fulfill God's calling in your life and sphere of influence. (5 Marks)
- b) **Identify** the tools through which the Holy Spirit aids in your spiritual development. How do these tools guide you in your spiritual journey? (5 Marks)

Question 5

- a) Reflect on your own personality, including your main traits and underlying temperaments. Give examples from your experiences to support your view on which of these qualities you possess. (5 Marks)

b) **Develop a personal plan**, rooted in Ephesians 2:10, to grow in alignment with God's purpose for you. What actionable steps will you take to fulfill your divine calling? (5 Marks)
